BREACH OF PROFESSIONAL DUTY



- Subject to the Organisation providing a professional service to its members, cover can be extended to include claims for Loss and Defence Costs arising from breach of professional duty



- Defamation, Fair Trading Act, Dishonesty and Fraud, Loss of Documents and Quasi Judicial Costs are included in this extension



- Max Capacity \$10,000,000 in the aggregate (part of D&O coverage)
